Polish Song Contest Rules for Non-Native Speakers

1. General Information

- The contest is open to all non-native speakers of Polish.
- Participants can apply to the contest as individuals or as teams.
- There is no age limit for participants.

2. Registration

- Participants must complete the registration form by the specified deadline.
- Each participant or team is allowed to submit one entry.

3. Contest Format

- The contest will consist of live performances.
- Performances must be in Polish.
- Each performance should not exceed 3 minutes.

4. Judging Criteria

- Performances will be judged based on the following criteria:
 - Pronunciation and diction
 - Musicality and melody
 - Stage presence and performance
 - Creativity and originality
 - Overall impression

5. Prizes

- The winners will be awarded cash prizes on the day of the contest:
 - 1st place: 500 PLN
 - 2nd place: 400 PLN
 - 3rd place: 300 PLN

6. Sponsorship

• Prizes are sponsored by Dunaj and other partner organizations.

7. Judges

- Judges will be selected and appointed by the partner organizations.
- The judges' decisions are final and binding.

8. Performance Rules

- All performances must be family-friendly and appropriate for all audiences.
- Any form of hate speech, offensive content, or inappropriate behavior will result in disqualification.

9. Rehearsal

• All participants are required to attend a mandatory rehearsal at the specified date and location provided prior to the contest.
